


Manatees Experience


Chichen Hza - Valladolid and Cenote


Floating canals and Kaan Luum lagoon

In the Mayan language, Sian Ka'an means 'Origin of the Sky', located on the east coast of the Yucatan peninsula, this biosphere reserve contains tropical forests and mangroves. It provides a habitat for a remarkably rich flora and a fauna comprising more than 300 species of birds, here you will go on a ride through the gorgeous lagoons of Muyil









and Chunyaxché, an incredible floating experience in crystal clear water. Afterwards, we'll visit the beautiful lagoon of Kaan Luum. What makes this lagoon so special? The colors of the water (blue and green) and the big cenote just in the center.




Coba - Punta Laguna


Tulum ruins - snorkel - Kaan Luum Lagoon
